

December 3, 1985

The Tontitown City Council met in regular session December 3, 1985, at the city hall with the following members present: Freddie Taldo, Mayor; Frances Franco, Recorder/Treasurer; Henry Piazza, Harry Sbanotto, Leon Zulpo, Joe Roso, and Gabe Pianalto, all aldermen.

Minutes and financial report were read and approved. Regular monthly bills were approved for payment.

Henry reported that Glen Meyer will start work on 2nd. street as soon as the ditch is dried up enough to work. Other than 2nd. street the streets are in pretty good shape.

Gabe reported that he had hauled 8 truck loads of trash last year, and Homer Smith had charged the city nothing. He is wondering if this is fair to Homer. The Mayor will talk to Homer to see if this is alright or if he wants the City to pay for this trash.

Salaries were brought up for discussion. Motion by Leon to increase salaries of the Mayor, Recorder/Treasurer, and the water Superintendent by 10%, and increase by \$5.00 (from \$25.00 to \$30.00) the pay per meeting for the entire council. Second by Henry. Motion carried. Four yes, one no.

Motion by Leon, second by Henry to have our Christmas party December 15 at Mary Maestri's at 7:00 P.M. Motion carried.

Henry asked about the Bastinelli house. There was discussion on how to heat and cool, should a stove be purchased or should we install central. After much discussion on how this house should be used and cared for, Leon made a motion to continue repairing as planned, buy a used stove, and use this building as a museum. Second by Henry. Motion carried. Three yes, One no, and one abstained.

Leon reported that the window leak was checked. The problem has been located, and will be repaired as soon as its dry enough.

A thank you note was read from Paul Ames concerning the street light installed at Hwy 68 West and County road 857. The Mayor reported that he has not received an answer from the state concerning the extension of the no passing zone.

Ordinances # 80 and 81 were read for the second time.

Motion to adjourn by Joe, second by Harry. Motion carried.
