

December 5, 1989

The Tontitown City council met in regular session December 5, 1989 at the city hall. Those present were: Freddie Taldo, Mayor; Frances Franco, Recorder/Treasurer; Henry Piazza, Leon Zulpo, Joe Roso, and Gabe Pionalto, all aldermen. Alderman Harry Sbanotto was absent.

Minutes and financial report were read and approved. Regular monthly bills were approved for payment. Also approved for payment was a bill from Waston's for \$126.00, Springdale News for \$276.42, and NAPCO for \$24.36.

The Mayor reported that he had called the EPA concerning the Red Barn Trailer Court. He was told the EPA could do nothing, and they suggested that he call the Health Dept. The Health Dept. told the Mayor they would do something.

Henry talked to Paul concerning Bandini Ave. Paul installed steel posts on both sides of Bandini Ave to keep the trucks from driving on the shoulder.

Mike Lewis will fix the shoulders on Barrington Rd., and will install curve signs near the Russell property. Rumble strips will also be installed near that curve. Two strips from the North, and two strips from the South. The cost will be \$2,465.00.

Henry also asked for a steel post mall to drive posts. He was told to purchase a steel mall for the city, and one to replace the one he broke that belonged to him.

There was discussion concerning the water dept. Harry has been in the hospital and there is no one who knows enough about the lines and valves to handle an emergency should one occur. Harry has been asking for someone to train for a long time, and the last month has convinced the council he was right. Leon talked to Gordon Slaughter to see if he might be interested in the job. Gordon is interested, so he will be invited to the January meeting to see what can be worked out. It was also decided that the salaries from the Water Dept. have been too low, Effective January 1, 1990, Harry's salary will be raised to \$1,500 a year-plus \$5.00 per hour for any labor done. The salary for the secretary will be raised from 50¢ to 75¢ per customer per month.

Leon made a motion to have the Christmas party, Sunday Dec. 10th. at Mary Meastri's at 7 p.m. Frances will take care of details.

There was discussion on building permits. Motion by Joe Roso, to raise the price of building permits from \$10.00 to \$20.00 beginning January 1, 1990. Second by Leon. Motion carried. 3 for 1 abstained, 1 absent.

Motion to adjourn by Leon, second by Joe. Motion carried.
