The Tontitown City Council met in special session December 17, 1990 at the city hall. The propose of the meeting was to discuss with C.R. Kidd his proposal to install mobile homes at the Ceola property on Sbanotto Ave.

Those present were: Fredie Taldo, Mayor; Frances Franco, Rec./Treas.; Henry Piazza, Gabe Pianalto, Leon Zulpo, and Harry Sbanotto, all aldermen. Pete Pianalto, Andy Franco, and Earl Mussino, from the Planning Commission; Gordon Slaughter with the water dept. and C.R.Kidd, and Gordon Cortiania were guests.

Mr. Kidd wants to put two mobile homes on the Ceola property. He plans on building foundations and car ports for each home. Ordinance #79 (placement of mobile homes) was read for information purposes.

Mr. Kidd said he will comply with ordinance #79, and will sign a statement saying he will not add any more mobile homes to this property that the two he is planning now. This being the case the council must approve these mobile homes.
