

December 19, 2000

The Tontitown City Council met in special session December 19, 2000 at the city hall. Those present were: Dan Watson, Mayor; Frances Franco, Recorder/Treasurer; Henry Piazza, Leon Zulpo, Arthur Penzo, Vanessa Sbanotto, and Ken Green all council members; and David Sbanotto, water superintendent.

The 2001 City Budget was presented to the council. The Mayor explained the \$270,000 budgeted for water line improvements. The engineers estimate for the Liberty Ave. water line from Brush Creek to the existing line on Liberty Ave is \$205,575. This is an 8" line all the way, but does not include land purchase for a water tower. We will also pay some on the Fantinel and the Colvin water lines. After much discussion Ordinance #146 was read for the first time. Henry made a motion to suspend the rule and read the second time. Second by Arthur. Motion carried. Second reading. Arthur made a motion to suspend the rule and read the third time. Second by Vanessa. Motion carried. Third reading. Leon made a motion to accept Ordinance #146 as read. Second by Ken. Motion carried.

A letter was read from the Springdale Water Department stating the water rates to the city will increase 1¢ per 1000 gallons in 2001. The water department will absorb this increase.

Resolution #84, A Resolution approving intermunicipal service agreement-Osage Basin Wastewater District, was read for approval. Motion by Ken to accept Resolution #84 as read. Second by Arthur. Motion carried.

The Mayor announced a meeting in Little Rock January 2, 2001 at 9:00 A.M. concerning grants for Osage Basin Wastewater District, and asked that the next meeting be moved to January 9, 2001. The council OK'ed the change.

Paul Colvin offered \$9,000 to install the water line to the fire hydrant in front of his building. The council decided \$9,000 is not enough from Mr. Colvin. The Mayor will speak to him again.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
