

Harry Sbanotto Park Rules

The City of Tontitown provides the facilities in the Harry Sbanotto Park for your use and enjoyment. Please take care to follow the following rules so that all may enjoy the Park in a safe and orderly manner.

- Reserved Pavilions and Gazebo are \$10/hour for a minimum of 2 hours with a maximum fee of \$60/day. To make a reservation, call the City's Administrative Assistant at (479) 361-2700 or email at adminasst@tontitown.com
- Use of the Pavilions and Gazebo are on a first-come, first-serve basis unless reserved through the City of Tontitown.
- Pets must be on a leash at all times and are never allowed on or around the playground areas. Please clean up after your pets and dispose of their wastes in a proper manner.
- Vandalism is a crime. Please take care of the Park restrooms. To report vandalism in the Park restrooms or other facilities in the Park, please contact the Washington Co. Sheriff's office or the Tontitown City Hall.
- Misuse or abuse of playground equipment, the Gazebo or other Park structures will result in a fine and dismissal from the Park facilities.
- No Alcoholic beverages allowed in the Park.
- No Parking on the Grass.
- If you use a Pavilion or Gazebo, please clean up after yourself. There are several trashcans located around the Park.
- No playground equipment is to be brought into the Park for private functions unless pre-approved by the Tontitown Park Committee, i.e. Inflatables, etc.
- No power cords or water hoses are to be placed in areas or across areas that would create a hazard to the public.
- No swinging or sitting on the Gazebo posts or railing.
- No motorized bikes in the Park.
