§111.03 PERMITS AND FEES.

- (A) Applications for all permits required by this chapter shall be made in writing to the Recorder/Treasurer. Each application shall state the name, address and telephone number of the applicant, the names of all owners, all names used in business, state and federal tax identification numbers, address of principal location, addresses of all annexes or any other buildings related to business, the number of individuals employed at each address, the time covered and the fee to be paid. Each application shall also contain any additional information that may be needed for the proper guidance of the city officials in issuing the permit applied for.
- (B) For each application, the person, firm, corporation or entity seeking the permit shall pay to the City of Tontitown a fee in the amount of \$300 prior to the issuance of the permit. The application fee shall be payable for each location intending to sell fireworks. This application process shall apply to each stand set up by a person, firm, corporation or entity when they desire to sell fireworks at two or more distinct physical locations within the corporate limits of the city.

№ § 111.04 BOND REQUIREMENT.

Before a permit is issued, the applicant shall file with the city a bond in the principal sum of \$250,000 or a public liability insurance policy for the same amount for the purpose of payment of any damages to persons or property which arise from or are caused by the conduct of any act authorized by the permit upon which any judicial ruling results. The Fire Official may specify a greater amount when in his or her opinion conditions at the location of the fireworks stand indicate a greater amount in required. (Ord. 142, passed 5-2-00)

	Generators or other internal combustion power sources shall be separated not less than 20 feet from tents and canopies.		
	Every firework stand shall have not less than 2 fire extinguishers with a minimum rating of 2A, at least one of which shall be of the pressurized water type.		
	Open flame or other devices emitting flame, fire or heater any flammable or combustible liquids, gas, charcoal or other cooking device or any other unapproved devices shall not be permitted inside or located within 20 feet of the tent or cappay.		



		Signage – A sign shall be conspicuously posted which states: "NO SMOKING! FIREWORKS SHALL NOT BE IGNITED, DISCHARGED OR OTHERWISE USED WITHIN 300 FEET OF THIS FACILITY"
		Clearance – There shall be a minimum of three feet between the fabric envelope and all contents located inside the tent structure.
		Exits shall be spaced at approximately equal intervals around the perimeter of the tent or canopy, and shall be located such that all points are 100 feet or less from an exit.
		Tents or canopies shall have at least 2 exits; the width of each exit shall not be less than 48 inches.
		The required width of exits, aisles and pass ways shall be maintained at all-time to a public way. Guy wires, guy ropes, and other support members shall not cross a means of egress at a height of less than 8 feet. The surface of means of egress shall be maintained in an approved manner.
		Tents and canopies shall have a permanently affixed label bearing the identification of size and fabric or material type
		Tents or canopies shall be composed of material meeting the flame propagation performance criteria of NFPA 701 or shall be flame retardant in an approved manner and meet the flame propagation performance of NFPA 701
The	foll	owing apply per the NFPA 101, Life Safety Code:
		Setbacks shall be 20' from buildings, 30' from combustibles and 10' from parking area.
		Electrical shall meet National Electrical Code. No open connections or spliced wires.
