Ordinance No. 3

An Ordinance creating the Office of Marshall of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown Arkansas.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown Arkansas;

- I That at each annual election of Offices of said Town, there may be elected as other Officers are elected, some competent person to serve as conservator of the peace and to perform such other duties as are imposed by the law upon the Marshalls of Incorporated Towns; which Officer shall be known as Marshall of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown Arkansas. Provided that the Council may in its discretion, fill said Office by appointment to be concurred in by a majority of the Council and approved by the Mayor.
- II That the Marshall shall be subject to the orders and directions of the Council and Mayor of said Town, and shall perform such duties as are now, or may be hereafter prescribed and imposed on him by the Statutes of the State of Arkansas, and Ordinances of said Town.
- III Unless otherwise determined by Ordinance the Marshall may be appointed Ex Officio Street Commissioner, which appointment shall be concurred in by a majority of the Council and approved by the Mayor.
- IV As compensation for his services as Marshall, that Officers shall have all fees, which he is by law entitled to charge for services rendered, in both civil and criminal cases when collected, but nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to in any way, charge the Town with fees not paid in cash.
- As further compensation for his services, the Council of said Town may, at its option by the unanimous vote of the Council and the approval of the Mayor, pay out of any funds in the Treasury applicable for such purpose such as stipulated monthly salary as they may determine which payments may be determined by a majority vote of the Council at any time, and nothing herein shall be construed to find the Town beyond the expressed will of the Council.
- VI That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from the date of organization and Incorporation of said Town.
