Ordinance No. 7

An Ordinance regulating and licensing circuses, menageries, shows, and theatrical and other exhibitions.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown Arkansas;

- That hereafter there shall be levied and collected as a town tax the sum of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) on each and every circus or menagerie for each exhibition given within the Corporated limits of the Town of Tontitown Arkansas. And the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) as town tax for each exhibition given by any show whether connected or not with such circus or menagerie.
- II There shall be levied and collected as a town tax the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00) for each public exhibition given by any person or persons within the said Corporate limits; any part of the proceeds of which are for the use and benefit of such person or persons; provided however that this Ordinance shall not apply to lectures, science, history or any literary subjects.
- III It shall be unlawful to give any of the exhibitions mentioned in this Ordinance without first proccuring license thereof, and it shall be the duty of the person or persons desiring to give any such exhibition to apply for and secure such license before any such exhibition shall be given, and a failure or a refusal to do so will be deemed a violation of this Ordinance and any person convicted thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25).
- IV All Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
