Ordinance No. 9

An Ordinance prohibiting stock and cattle to run at large.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown Arkansas;

- I That it is hereby made unlawful for any person to permit his horses, mules, cattle, hogs and sheep or goats to run at large within the Corporate limits of said Incorporated Town.
- II It shall be the duty of the Marshall of the said Incorporated Town to impound any such stock found at large and the said Marshall shall notify the owners or the agent of the stock impounded.
- III The owner or agent of the impounded stock shall pay the fine of Twenty-Five Cents (\$.25) per capita and the damage done by such stock.
- IV The assessement of such damage will be done according to the law of the State of Arkansas of the Kirby's Digest, Chapter 149 and Section 7880.
- V This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
