## Ordinance No. 10

An Ordinance in relation to Lemonade Stands, Sewing, Merry-Go-Rounds, Lunch Counters, Knife Racks, Cane Racks, Doll Racks, Shooting Galleries, and all other things of like nature or character kept either for refreshment amusement of profits on public days. Pic-Nic Days or Celebrations Days of any kind or date within the Incorporated Town of Tontitown Arkansas, and providing for the payment of a license for the privilege of transacting such business and operating any such devices.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown Arkansas;

- I That no general license Ordinance shall apply to special licenses issued for public days, Pic-Nic Days or Celebration Days of any kind or date.
- II That for the privilege of conducting any business or operating any device within the Incorporated Town of Tontitown Arkansas, herein after enumerated on any public day, Pic-Nic Day or Celebration Day of any kind or date, there shall be first paid as a license by the owner or operator of such business or device the following amounts:

  For each and every Merry-Go-Round the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per day.

  For each Knife Rack, Cane Rack or Doll Rack the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00) per day.

  For each Spin Wheel or Toy Stand the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00) per day.

  For each Lunch Stand the sum of Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2.50) per day.

  For each Lemonade Stand or Ice Cream Stand the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) per day.

  For each Photographic or Picture outfit of any kind the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) per day.

  For each Notion Stand or peddler of any kind the sum of Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2.50) per day.
- III That any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance by failing or refusing to pay the license as herein provided before engaging in any business herein placed on the license list, shall be deemed quilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof before the Mayor of said Town shall be fined in any sum not exceeding Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00).
- IV That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
