## Ordinance No. 12

An Ordinance to provide for the registration of persons, births and deaths.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown Arkansas;

- I That hereafter all the persons, the heads of families who may become residents of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown, or any person who shall have attained the age of Twenty-One years, who may become a resident of said Town, shall within Thirty (30) days after becoming such resident register with the Recorder of said Incorporated Town, his name, age and the names and ages of all persons who compose his immediate family, or those dependant upon him.
- II The head of a family, shall report to the Recorder of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown, each birth and death in his family, within three (3) days after the same shall have occured, and if in the case of a death there shall be no relatives, or the party shall not be a member of a household, the attending physician shall report the said death.
- III The Recorder shall file and keep a register of all births and deaths within the said Incorporated Town, in a book furnished him for that purpose.
- IV Any person failing to register as provided in Section I of this Ordinance, or who shall fail to register any birth or death, shall be fined in any sum not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) nor more than Five Dollars (\$5.00).
- V All Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and this Ordinance shall be in effect and full force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
