Ordinance No. 13

An Ordinance regulating the fees and saleries of the Officers of the Town of Tontitown Arkansas.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown Arkansas;

- I That the Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Tontitown shall serve without compensation, except the fees allowed the Mayor by law.
- II That the Marshall of the Town of Tontitown shall receive in addition to the fees allowed him by law such compensation as the Council appointing him may direct, the same to be paid out if the Town Treasury as other demands.
- III That the Recorder of the Town of Tontitown shall receive Twenty-Five Cents (\$.25) for each license issued by him, the same to be paid out of the Town Treasury as other demands, and other compensation.
- IV That hereafter the Street Commissioner of the Town of Tontitown shall be allowed the sum of One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per day for each day that he may be on duty, the same to be paid out of the Town Treasury as other demands.
- V That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
