

Ordinance No. 14

An Ordinance regulating the meetings of the Town Council of Tontitown Arkansas.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown Arkansas;

- I That the time for the regular meeting of the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown Arkansas shall be on the first Monday of each month, commencing at half past Seven o'clock (7:00) P.M.
- II All Council meetings shall be held at such place as may be provided by the Town Council.
- III The Mayor may call special meetings of the Council when in his judgment he deems it necessary for the transaction of any special business necessary to be transacted before the next regular meetings, and it shall be the duty of the Mayor to cause written notice of all special meetings to be served on each member of the Council, One (1) day before such meetings, specifying therein in general terms the particular business to be transacted.
- IV That the Mayor may call a special meeting of the Council at any time upon written request of a majority of the Town Council, provided notice of such special meeting be given to each member of the Council.
- V That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
