

Ordinance No. 19

An Ordinance to preserve the peace and to prevent assaults and battery in the Incorporated Town of Tontitown Arkansas.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown Arkansas;

- I It is hereby made unlawful for any person within the Corporate limits of the Town of Tontitown to make use of any profane, violent, abusive or insulting language toward another person, in his presence or hearing which language in its common acceptation is calculated to arouse to anger the person about or to whom it is spoken or addresses, or to cause a breach of the peace or an assault.
- II Every person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a breach of the peace, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not less than Five nor more than Three Hundred Dollars.
- III That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
