

Ordinance No. 22

An Ordinance defining assaults and batteries and to punish the same within the Corporate limits of Tontitown Arkansas.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown Arkansas;

- I Whoever shall unlawfully attempt to commit a violent injury on the person of any other within the Corporate limits of the Town of Tontitown Arkansas, shall be deemed guilty of an assault.
- II Whoever shall unlawfully strike or beat the person of another within the Corporated limits of the Town of Tontitown Arkansas shall be deemed guilty of an assault and battery.
- III That any person convicted of a violation of Section I of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine in any sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars.
- IV Be it further ordained that if any person be convicted of a violation of Section II of this Ordinance he shall be punished by a fine in any sum not exceeding Two Hundred Dollars.
- V Be it further ordained that any person within the Corporate limits of the Town of Tontitown Arkansas, assaulting another with a deadly weapon, instrument or other thing with the intent to inflict upon the person of another a bodily injury, where no considerable provocation appears, or where the circumstances show an abandoned and malignant disposition, shall upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine in any sum not less than Fifty Dollars nor more than One Thousand Dollars, and be imprisoned in the Town jail not more than One year.
- VI That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
