

Ordinance No. 23

An Ordinance to punish petty larceny within the Corporate limits of the Town of Tontitown Arkansas.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown Arkansas;

- I That any person or persons who shall within the Corporate limits of the Town of Tontitown Arkansas, commit larceny by stealing any monies, bills, notes, chattels, goods, wares, merchandise, or other property of whatever name or nature not exceeding in value Ten Dollars shall be deemed guilty of a violation of this Ordinance and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by imprisonment in the Town prison not more than One year, and shall be fined in any sum not less than Ten nor more than Three Hundred Dollars.
- II Whoever shall receive or buy any of the stolen property mentioned in Section I of this Ordinance, knowing the same to be stolen with the intent to deprive the true owner thereof, shall upon conviction, be punished as prescribed in this Ordinance for larceny of such property.
- III That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
