

Ordinance No. 27

An Ordinance regulating the speed of Motor Vehicles and Motorcycles.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown Arkansas;

- I That it shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive or cause to be operated or driven on or through the streets of the Town of Tontitown Arkansas any automobile, motorcycle or any other vehicle known as a motor vehicle, at a greater rate of speed than Fifteen miles per hour.
- II That it shall be unlawful for any person under the age of Eighteen years of age to drive or operate any such motor vehicle on or through the streets of the Town of Tontitown Arkansas.
- III That any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction before the Mayor be fined in any sum not less than Five Dollars nor more than Twenty-Five Dollars.
- IV That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
