

ORDINANCE NO. 44

Be it ordained by the town council of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown, Arkansas;

Sec.1. That hereafter it shall be unlawful for any person to post advertisements within the corporate limits of said Town, without having first procured license therefor from the recorder of said Incorporation.

Sec.2. The license herein specified shall be imposed and collected for billboards at the rate of \$5.00 (five Dollars) per annum for each board of any size.

Sec.3. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in any sum not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00 for each offense. Provided however that no license shall be collected for the posting of official notices, religious or educational notices or advertisements or notices by persons residing within the Incorporated Town of Tontitown, Arkansas.

Sec.4. This Ordinance to take effect and be in force from and after its date of passage.
