

Ordinance No. 33

An Ordinance restricting parking in certain areas at certain times within the Incorporated Town of Tontitown, Ark.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the Incorporated Town of Tontitown, Arkansas.

- I That hereafter no person shall park a vehicle of any sort nor obstruct in anyway the free passage of motor drawn vehicles in front of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in the Incorporated Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, between the no parking signs now erected or which may be hereafter erected in front of the said church on Sundays (The Christian Sabbath) Holy Days of Obligation, or special occasions when the church is used.
- II This no parking zone is meant to extend on the north side of Highway 68 from the junction of Barrington Road, east along the north side of Highway 68 for a distance of some one hundred (100) feet, which area is now marked by no parking signs.
- III Parking in the said area may be prohibited at other times by proclamation of the Mayor, when parking in such area would constitute a traffic hazard.
- IV Any person found guilty of violating this Ordinance shall on conviction thereof be fined in the sum of not less than One Dollar nor more than Ten Dollars for each offense and each days violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Whereas, the parking of vehicles in front of the church at the time worship is being conducted on Holy Days of Obligation or other special occasions, constitutes a traffic hazard to the lives and property of the traveling public and the people attending the church at such hours, an emergency is hereby declared and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
