

Ordinance No. 34

An Ordinance fixing the salary and compensation to be paid to the Mayor, Secretary & Recorder, Treasurer, and Aldermen of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, repealing all Ordinances in conflict therewith, and creating an emergency and for other purposes.

Whereas the salaries and compensation now paid the Mayor, Secretary & Recorder, Treasurer, and Aldermen of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, are inadequate and insufficient to compensate them for their services rendered to the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, and said salaries and compensation should be increased to properly compensate said officials for their services;

Now therefore, be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, by the unanimous vote of all the members elected to the Council;

- I Hereafter the Mayor of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall receive the sum of \$40.00 per annum as his salary as Mayor, and he shall receive the further sum of \$1.00 for each meeting of the Council that he attends.
- II The Secretary & Recorder of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall receive the sum of \$20.00 per annum as salary for his office, and he shall receive and be paid the sum of \$1.00 for each meeting of the Council that he attends.
- III The Treasurer of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall receive the sum of \$10.00 per annum as salary for his services to said Town.
- IV Each Alderman shall receive the sum of \$1.00 for each meeting of the Council that may be attended during the term of office.
- V Ordinance No. 30 of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, in so far as it conflicts with this Ordinance is hereby repealed, and all Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.
- VI This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
