

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-02-410

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 30.05(B)(7) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State of Arkansas allows municipalities to make electronic fund payments due to the convenience of electronic payments, pursuant to A.C.A. 14-59-105; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Tontitown to make certain payments via electronic payment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Code Section 30.05(B)(7) of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Tontitown, Arkansas is hereby repealed.

SECTION 1. Code Section 30.05(B)(7), shall read as follows: "The Recorder/Treasurer shall establish an electronic payment method that is approved by the current auditor and provides for internal accounting controls and documentation for audit and accounting purposes."

SECTION 3. Emergency Clause. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare, and the uninterrupted operation of city government, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
