ORDINANCE NO. 41

AN ORDINANCE ENTIFLED: "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF CHICKEN OR POULTRY HOUSES IN THE TOWN OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDANED by the Town Council of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas:

Section 1. From and after passage of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to build, erect or construct any chicken or poultry houses or structures related in any manner to the production of poultry within the corporate limits of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, except as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation desiring to build, erect or construct such chicken or poultry houses within the corporate limits of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall make application of approval of the location, design or use of said poultry houses or similar structures to the Town Council of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, prior to commencement of construction.

Section 3. The Town Council of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall have sole discretion in extending the approval of any application submitted to it pursuant to this ordinance.

Section 4. Any person commencing construction, or constructing, or causing to be constructed, any such chicken or poultry houses or other structure related thereto within the corporate limits of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, without first having secured approval of the Town Council of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction, shall be fined not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$250.00, and each and every day that said chicken or poultry houses or related structure remains within the corporate limits of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, or construction continues toward the erection of same, shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 5. Any such chicken or poultry houses or related structures commenced or erected within the corporate limits of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, without the approval of the Town Council of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, as heretofore set forth, shall constitute a nuisance per se to the citizens of the Town of Tontitown,

Arkansas.

Section 6. It is further found that this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare, and an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its ps
