

ORDINANCE NO. 56

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 51 OF THE  
TOWN OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, WHICH ORDINANCE  
IS KNOWN AS THE BOND ORDINANCE OF SAID TOWN

WHEREAS, Tontitown, an incorporated town in Washington County, Arkansas (sometimes hereinafter called Town), has constructed and is operating a municipal water system made possible through the sale of water revenue bonds; and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 51 of said Town authorizing the issuance of said water revenue bonds provided that the fiscal year of the Tontitown water system would commence on January 1 and end on December 31 of each year; and,

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be to the best interest of the said Tontitown water system that said fiscal year commence on October 1 of each calendar year and end on September 30 of each calendar year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS:

Section I

That the Bond Ordinance, Ordinance No. 51 of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, be and the same is hereby amended to provide that the fiscal year of the Tontitown water system commence on October 1 of each calendar year and end on September 30 of each calendar year.

Section II

That all parts of said ordinance relating to said fiscal year are hereby amended to comply with the new fiscal year as created by this amendment.

Section III

That all provisions of said Ordinance 51 not hereby specifically amended shall remain in full force and effect.

Section IV

That because there is no newspaper published in the Town of Tontitown, the Mayor and Town Recorder are hereby directed to post more than ten days before the date fixed for the hearing, a certified copy of this ordinance in five of the most public places within the said

Town of Tontitown, attached to a notice of hearing signed by them, in substantially the following form:
