

ORDINANCE NO. 69

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING TERRITORY ANNEXED TO THE
CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, by Order of the Washington County Court dated January 22, 1979, certain territory, hereinafter described, was annexed to the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, and on the 23 day of February, 1979, said annexation was confirmed by Order of the Washington County Court; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent and desire of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, to accept said annexed territory into the corporate limits of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the territory hereinafter described should be, and the same hereby is accepted as annexed territory into the corporate limits of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, the said territory being in Washington County, Arkansas, described as follows:

North 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4,
North 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4,
South 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4,
South 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4,
South 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4,
all in Section 3, ALSO
South 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4, and
North 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4, all
in Section 4.
All of the above-described land being in
Township 17 North, Range 31 West,
Washington County, Arkansas

SECTION 2: The orderly planning and development of the corporate land of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, and land adjacent to the main arterial roads and streets coming into the City is in jeopardy due to a

lack of proper and complete authority of the City to plan, regulate and zone and, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
