AN ORDINANCE VACATING CERTAIN ALLEYS IN THE

ORIGINAL TOWN OF TOWN

ORIGINAL TOWN OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, a petition was filed with the Town Council of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, on the 2nd day of September, 1980, asking that the Town Council vacate and abandon the following described alley situate in the Original Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, to-wit:

A Twenty (20') foot alley beginning on the East end of Block 14 and continuing through Blocks 14, 15, 16 and 17 in the Original Town of Tontitown, Washington County, Arkansas.

WHEREAS, after due notices as required by law, the Council has at the time and place mentioned in the notice, heard all persons desiring to be heard on the question, and has ascertained that the alleys hereinabove described have heretofore been dedicated to the public use as alleys; have not been actually used by the public generally for a period of at least five years subsequent to the filing of said petition; that petitioners are a majority of the sole owners of the property abutting all of said alleys; and, that public interest and welfare will not be adversely affected by the abandonment of said alleys.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, that:

- (1) The Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, hereby releases, vacates and abandons all its rights, together with the rights of the public generally in and to the alleys hereinabove described.
- (2) A copy of this Ordinance duly certified by the Town Recorder shall be filed in the Office of the Recorder of the County, and recorded in the Deed Records of the County.
- (3) This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
