AN ORDINANCE RELEASING, VACATING, AND ABANDONING A CERTAIN ALLEY IN THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, after due notices as required by law, the Council has, at the time and place mentioned in the notice, heard all persons desiring to be heard on the question and has ascertained that the alley, hereinbefore described has heretofore been dedicated to the public use as an alley herein described; has not been actually used by the public generally for a period of at least five years subsequent to the filing of the plat; that all of the owners of the property abutting upon the portion of the alley to be vacated have filed with the Council their written consent to such abandonment; and that public interest and welfare will not be adversely affected by the abandonment of such alley.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas:

SECTION 1. The City of Tontitown, Arkansas, hereby releases, vacates and abandons all its rights, together with the rights of the public generally, in and to the alley designated as follows: The alley sought to be abandoned is the alley which separates Lots 1 through 6, Block 30, from Lots 7 through 18, Block 30 of the Original Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, as per the recorded plat of said Addition, a copy of which is attached

hereto and made a part hereof as though set forth herein word for word.

SECTION 2. A copy of the Ordinance duly certified to by the City Clerk shall be filed in the Office of the Recorder of the County and recorded in the Deed Records of the County.

SECTION 3. It is hereby declared that an emergency exists, and this Ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

PETITION TO VACATE ALLEY
