

ORDINANCE NO. 77

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN,
WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS

An Ordinance to vacate an alley going through Block Thirty-One (31) of the Original Town of Tontitown, Arkansas.

WHEREAS, on the 18th day of May, 1983 the owner of Block Thirty-One (31) of the Original Town of Tontitown, Arkansas, Petitioned the Mayor and City Council of Tontitown, Arkansas to vacate an alley going through said Block Thirty-One (31).

WHEREAS said alley runs east and west through said Block Thirty-One (31), has not been used by the public for a period of more than five (5) years and is therefore subject to be closed and vacated by law.

WHEREAS it would be in the best interests of the citizens of Tontitown, Arkansas that said alley going through said Block Thirty-One (31) be closed and vacated.

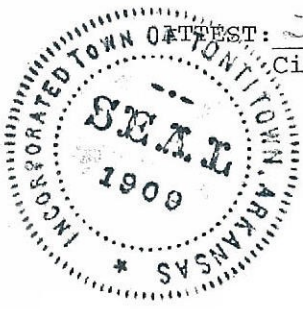
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
