

**RESOLUTION #66-A**  
**OF THE**  
**CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS**

This Resolution made by the City Council of the City of Tontitown this 3rd day of September, 1996 at a meeting of a quorum of the councilpersons of the City of Tontitown, which Resolution was passed by unanimous vote as follows:

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown is a city of the second class which does not currently have an elected municipal attorney or an appointed municipal attorney; and

WHEREAS, from time to time it is necessary to cause certain ordinances and laws of the City of Tontitown to be enforced; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-42-112 allows the City Council of a city of a second class to appoint a municipal attorney when no attorney resides in the limits of the city or when no resident attorney has been elected; and

WHEREAS, James E. Crouch is authorized to practice law in the State of Arkansas;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Tontitown, that James E. Crouch of Cypert, Crouch, Clark & Harwell is hereby appointed as the municipal attorney for the City of Tontitown and is authorized to appoint, from time to time, in his discretion, attorneys from his office of Cypert, Crouch, Clark & Harwell, as deputy city attorneys for the purpose of acting on behalf of the City as its attorney and to be paid on an hourly basis or a fee for service basis based on the work performed from time to time;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the attorney as appointed above shall serve from the commencement of the oath of office until his successor is appointed, elected, or until he resigns and at such time as he resigns, all attorneys in his office shall also be considered by the City to have resigned as deputy city attorneys.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the attorneys above appointed shall be authorized to file information for the arrest of any person for the violation of any ordinance of the City of Tontitown or the laws of this state which are violated within the limits of this city; provided,

however, that nothing contained herein shall prohibit the filing of information for the arrest of any person for violation of any ordinance of this city or the laws of this state which are violated within the limits of this city by any prosecuting attorney or deputy prosecuting attorney in Washington County authorized to do so by the laws of the State of Arkansas.

It is hereby declared that an emergency exists and this Resolution, being necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
