

ORDINANCE NO. 126

AN ORDINANCE TO RENAME THE TONTITOWN CITY PARK;
CHANGING THE NAME TO "HARRY SBANOTTO PARK".

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Tontitown to remember Harry Joseph Sbanotto, the former Mayor of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas; and recognize the positive affects that he has had on the community; and that the City Park be renamed in memory of him; and that this ordinance is necessary to accomplish these purposes.

WHEREAS, the Tontitown City Council recognizes that Harry Joseph Sbanotto has made many significant contributions to the proper and orderly development of the City during his life; and that the City expanded in positive directions along with his guidance, while he served for many years as the Mayor of Tontitown. Recognizing his efforts and the numerous contributions that he has made, the Tontitown City Council deems that the City Park shall be renamed "Harry Sbanotto Park" in memory of him; and

WHEREAS, the Tontitown City Council held a public hearing on October 6, 1998 to hear comments or arguments, both for and against the renaming of the City Park, and at that public hearing no objections to the renaming of the City Park were raised; and

WHEREAS, the Tontitown City Council has prepared an ordinance for the renaming the Tontitown City Park, changing the name to "Harry Sbanotto Park".

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In memory of Harry Joseph Sbanotto, The Tontitown City Park shall be renamed after him. The Tontitown City Park shall forever be known as "Harry Sbanotto Park", from this day forward.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective 30 (thirty) days after its passage and approval.
