ORDINANCE NO. 130

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF TONTITOWN ARKANSAS; AND MAKING A PART OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, petition was filed with the County Clerk of Washington county, Arkansas by the majority of the real estate owners of the hereinafter described territory praying that said territory be annexed to and made a part of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, and;

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The City council determines that an emergency exists and this Ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall be in effect from and after its approval, passage, publication and the recording of a certified copy thereof with the Recorder of Washington County, Arkansas.
