## ORDINANCE NO. 146

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 92, THE SAME BEING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, AND THE PLAT PERTAINING THERETO, FOR REZONING PETITION NO. 9192000A, THE PETITIONERS BEING MAESTRI ENTERPRISES, L.L.C.; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

WHEREAS, the Tontitown Planning Commission of the City of Tontitown, Washington County, Arkansas, gave notice as required by law and set a hearing date of September 19, 2000, for hearing the matter of redistricting the hereinafter described tract of real estate:

The rezoning to C-Commercial from A-Agricultural, of areas of land described as follows:

Part of the East Half (E1/2) of the fractional Northeast Quarter (NE1/4) of Section one (1), Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Thirty One (31) West, Washington County, Arkansas, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of said East Half of the Fractional NE1/4, of said Section 1; thence North 87 degrees 13'49" West 661.80 feet; thence North 02 degrees 02'51'11" East 38.69 feet; thence North 02 degrees 51' 11" east 256.19 feet; thence North 03 degrees 00'27" East 331 feet; thence North 03 degrees 00'27" East 462.84 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence North 86 degrees 35'59" West 344.65 feet; thence North 03 degrees 00'44" East 505.51 feet; thence South 87 degrees 10'38" East 344.60 feet; thence south 03 degrees 00'27" West 508.98 feet to the Point of Beginning, containing 4.01 acres, more or less, and subject to easements and/or rights-of-way, if any.

AND WHEREAS, after giving notice as required by law, the Tontitown Planning Commission of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, held a hearing; and after hearing arguments for and against such rezoning; and the Tontitown Planning Commission feeling that the area described herein should not be redistricted and changed from (A)-Agricultural to (C)-Commercial was not able to vote favorably for the above mentioned petition, and therefore the petition to rezone the above described property was denied.

AND WHEREAS, the petitioners feeling that the Planning Commission's decision was made in error, filed an appeal to the Tontitown City Council to reconsider the rezoning of the above described property.

AND WHEREAS, the appeal was heard at the November 17, 2000 meeting of the Tontitown City Council in regular session assembled;

AND WHEREAS, after hearing arguments for and against such rezoning; and the Tontitown City Council feeling that the area described herein should be redistricted and changed from (A)- Agricultural to (C)-Commercial in that the purpose of the Zoning Ordinance would be more properly carried out by such redistricting; and that unless granted, citizens of Tontitown will suffer irreparable harm and damage, and will be substantially deprived of the use of their property; passed and approved the rezoning of the property hereinafter described.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No.92, the Amendments thereto, and the Zoning Plat pertaining thereto of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, are hereby amended by rezoning the hereinafter described tract from (A)-Agricultural to (C)-Commercial as follows:

Part of the East Half (E1/2) of the fractional Northeast Quarter (NE1/4) of Section one (1), Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Thirty One (31) West, Washington County, Arkansas, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of said East Half of the Fractional NE1/4, of said Section 1; thence North 87 degrees 13'49" West 661.80 feet; thence North 02 degrees 02'51'11" East 38.69 feet; thence North 02 degrees 51' 11" east 256.19 feet; thence North 03 degrees 00'27" East 331 feet; thence North 03 degrees 00'27" East 462.84 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence North 86 degrees 35'59" West 344.65 feet; thence North 03 degrees 00'44" East 505.51 feet; thence South 87 degrees 10'38" East 344.60 feet; thence south 03 degrees 00'27" West 508.98 feet to the Point of Beginning, containing 4.01 acres, more or less, and subject to easement and/or rights-of-way, if any.

SECTION 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE: The City council determines that an emergency exists and this Ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall be in effect from and after its approval, passage, publication and the recording of a certified copy thereof with the Recorder of Washington County, Arkansas.
