WHEREAS, the City proposes to obtain funds to accomplish the Project from the proceeds of a water and sewer revenue bond (the "City Bond") to be issued by the City and purchased by the Arkansas Soil and Water Conservation Commission (the "Commission") as a part of the Arkansas Water, Waste Disposal and Pollution Abatement Facilities General Obligation Bond Program (the "Program"); and
WHEREAS, the purchase price for the Project will be paid from Commission funds made available by the Program ("Program funds"); and
WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the Project is two hundred seventy thousand one hundred (\$ 270,100.00);
AND WHEREAS, the purpose of this Resolution is for the City to declare its "official intent" for the issuance of the City Bond within the meaning of the applicable income tax regulations promulgated by the United States Treasury Department.
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tontitown , Arkansas:
Section 1. The City hereby expresses its intent to advance its own funds to pay costs of the Project, including but not limited to legal, engineering, and right-of-way costs and with Commission approval, to reimburse itself from Program Funds for all expenditures for costs paid by the City prior to the issuance of the City Bond. Section 2. The City expects that, but does not limit the sources of funds to be
