AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 92, THE SAME BEING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, AND THE PLAT PERTAINING THERETO, FOR REZONING PETITION NO. 8212001A, THE PETITIONERS BEING MIKE AND PHYLLIS HALE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."
