

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-1-199

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THAT THE POSITION  
OF CITY ATTORNEY FOR THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS  
BE AN APPOINTED POSITION, AND PROVIDING FOR THE  
APPOINTMENT THEREOF; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown is a city of the second class; and,

WHEREAS, Ark. Code Ann. Section 14-42-112 provides that the office of City Attorney may be an appointed position upon the passage of an ordinance for that purpose; and,

WHEREAS, the interests of the City and its citizens will be better served by filling the office of City Attorney by appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TONTITOWN,  
ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the office of City Attorney for the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, is hereby established as an appointed position.

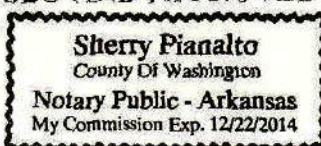
Section 2. Either the Mayor or any alderman may present a name for the appointment of City Attorney. The appointment shall be approved by a majority vote of the City Council.

Section 3. The duties of the City Attorney shall be those as set forth in Ark. Code Ann. Section 14-42-112, and such other duties as provided by state law or which may be prescribed by ordinance.

Section 4. The compensation of the City Attorney shall be set on an hourly bases or a fee for services based on the work performed from time to time.

Section 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE: The City Council determines that an emergency exists and this Ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall be in effect from and after its approval, passage, publication and the recording of a certified copy thereof with the Recorder of Washington County, Arkansas.
