AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 172 IN ORDER TO ENACT AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance No. 172 approved August 5, 2003, (Ordinance 172); and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas to amend Ordinance No. 172 to promote the effective development, operation, and maintenance of those existing parks requires administrative oversight in order to best preserve and protect the assets of those parks, to create an atmosphere which is inviting to the public, and to address the development of future parks; and

WHEREAS, the needs as outlined above could be the accomplished by the creation of a Parks and Recreation Commission for the City of Tontitown;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section one of Ordinance No. 172 is hereby amended to read as follows:

That a Parks and Recreation Commission for the City of Tontitown is hereby established. The Commission shall consist of six (6) members who shall be appointed by the Mayor for a term of three (3) years. At all times, one (1) member of the Commission shall be a member of the Tontitown City Council. Vacancies on the Commission shall be filled in the same manner as appointments.

Section 2: That the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be separable, and if any provision shall for any reason be held illegal or invalid, it shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

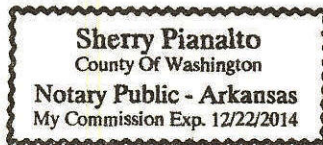
Section 3: That all Ordinances and parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4: That Ordinance No. 172, as amended, hereby shall remain and be in full force and effect.

Section 5: Emergency Clause: It is hereby declared that an emergency exists, and this Ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall be effective from and after its passage and approval.
