

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-3203 File **2005-00011289**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, is currently and will continue to experience both economic and population growth; and

**WHEREAS**, the effective development, growth, operation and expansion of both the corporate boundaries and growth areas of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, requires administrative oversight in order to best preserve, plan and protect the City of Tontitown and its citizens; to create an atmosphere which is inviting to the general public at large and the present and future citizens of the City of Tontitown; and

**WHEREAS**, the needs as outlined above could be accomplished by the creation of an Advisory Committee for the City of Tontitown;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** That an Advisory Committee for the City of Tontitown is hereby established. The Committee shall serve in an advisory capacity only and shall consist of ten (10) members who shall be appointed by the Mayor for a term of one (1) year. At all times, one (1) member of the Committee shall be a member of the Tontitown City Council, who shall serve in an ex officio capacity and who shall serve as a liaison between the committee and the City Council and who shall have no power to vote. Vacancies on the Committee shall be filled in the same manner as appointments.

**Section 2:** Members of the Committee shall not receive compensation for their services, except that members may recover costs and expenses in the event they are required to travel, pursuant to business related to the Committee.

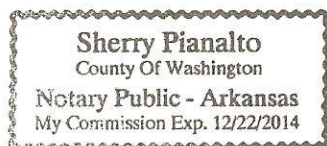
**Section 3:** The Committee shall, if necessary, enact bylaws for its operation, and shall report, from time to time, to the City Council of Tontitown regarding the Committee's projects and overall operation.

**Section 4:** Emergency Clause: It is hereby declared that an emergency exists, in that, a comprehensive plan is needed for the preservation, planning and protection of the City

of Tontitown, Arkansas, and this Ordinance, for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall be effective from and after its passage and approval.
