ORDINANCE NO. 2005-3-211

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THAT THE POSITION OF CITY RECORDER AND CITY TREASURER FOR THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS BE A COMBINED POSITION FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown is a city of the second class; and,

WHEREAS, Ark. Code Ann. Section 14-44-114 provides that the offices of City Recorder and City Treasurer may be a combined position upon the passage of an ordinance for that purpose; and,

WHEREAS, the interests of the City of Tontitown and its citizens will be better served by combining the office of City Recorder and City Treasurer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. That the offices of City Recorder and City Treasurer for the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, is hereby established as a combined position, herein after known as the Recorder Treasurer for the City of Tontitown, Arkansas.
- Section 2. The duties of the City Recorder Treasurer shall be those as set forth by the laws of the State of Arkansas, and such other duties as provided by or which may be prescribed by ordinance.
- Section 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE: The City Council determines that an emergency exists in that the effective administration of city government would be hindered if this Ordinance is not passed and this Ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall be in effect from and after its approval and passage.
