ORDINANCE NO. 2005-S-219

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND GRANTING RECORDER / TREASURER SUPERVISORY AUTHORITY OVER THE POSITION OF THE WATER CLERK FOR THE CITY OF TONTITOWN AND FOR OTHER PURPOSE.**

**WHEREAS**, Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-44-109, empowers the City Council to prescribed by ordinance the duties of the Recorder / Treasurer, and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance #210, subsection (q) states "*such duties as from time to time be directed by the Council in ordinances and resolutions; (please refer to ACA § 14-44-109)*"

**WHEREAS**, the Recorder / Treasurer is responsible for the financial records and the financial transactions of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, and it is in the best interest of the City of Tontitown to authorize and direct that the Recorder / Treasurer have the authority to supervise and control the activities and duties of the Water Clerk of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** That the Recorder / Treasurer of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas is hereby authorized to supervise and control the activities and duties of the Water Clerk of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas.


**Section 2:** That the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be separable, and if any provision shall for any reason be held illegal or invalid, it shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

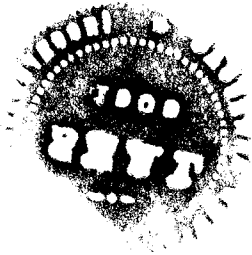
**Section 3:** That all Ordinances and parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 4:** That the City Council, of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, determines that an emergency exists in the administration of governmental operations in the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, and this Ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall be in full force and be in effect from and after passage and approval.
