AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2005-3-207. ESTABLISHING A FINANCE COMMITTEE, (PASSED MARCH 15, 2005) AND ORDINANCE NO. 2005-3-208, ESTABLISHING A STREET COMMITTEE, (PASSED MARCH 15, 2005), IN ORDER TO ENACT AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AND CREATE A STREET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANASAS, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas to repeal Ordinance No. 2005-3-201 (passed March 15, 2005) and Ordinance No. 2005-3-208 (passed March 15, 2005); and

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, has and maintains certain monies, financial accounts, liabilities and obligations; and

WHEREAS, the effective plan, operation, and administration of existing and future financial accounts, liabilities and obligations require administrative oversight in order to best maintain, develop and assure that the financial obligations of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, are maintained in a manner, which is in the best interest of the public and to address the development of the future of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, has and contains certain roadways and streets within its corporate boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the effective development, growth, operation and maintenance of those existing roadways and streets require administrative oversight in order to best maintain, develop and protect the roadways and

streets, to create and atmosphere which is safe to the public, and to address the development of future roadways and streets; and

WHEREAS, the needs as outlined above could be the accomplished by the creation of a Street and Finance Committee for the City of Tontitown;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a Street and Finance Committee, for the City of Tontitown, is hereby established. The Committee shall consist of four (4) members with one (1) member from each ward exclusive of the chairman and who shall be appointed and approved by the City Council for a term of one (1) year. At all times, the members of this Committee shall be Aldermen in the Tontitown City Council. Vacancies on the Committee shall be filled in the same manner as appointments.

<u>Section 2:</u> Members of the Committee shall not receive compensation for their services, except that members may recover costs and expenses in the event they are required to travel, pursuant to business related to the Committee.

<u>Section 3:</u> The Committee shall, if necessary, enact bylaws for its operation, and shall report, from time to time, to the City Council of Tontitown regarding the Committee's projects and overall operation.

<u>Section 4:</u> Emergency Clause: It is hereby declared that an emergency exists, in that, an effective plan, for the operation and administration of those existing, future and financial accounts, liabilities and obligations is needed, for the effective development and preservation of the financial records, liabilities and obligations of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, as well as a comprehensive plan for the construction, maintenance, development and preservation of the roadways and streets of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, and this Ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall be effective from and after its passage and approval.
