

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-01-244

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING A JUNK CAR LAW FOR THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, declares that unlicensed and inoperative motor vehicles are an unsanitary and unsightly condition.

WHEREAS, A.C.A. 27-50-1201, et, seq., sets out Arkansas law on law enforcement officers towing vehicles that are parked on or near a public way, and A.C.A. 8-6-402, et, seq., sets out disposing of junk vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, does hereby adopt, word for word, the provision of A.C.A 27-50-1201, et, seq. and A.C.A. 8-6-402, et, seq.

Section 2: Emergency Clause. It is hereby declared that our emergency exists, and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
