ORDINANCE NO. <u>94610-</u>44-258

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2005-3-204 AND TO ENACT AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE MEETINGS OF TOWN COUNCIL OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2005-3-204, approved March 1, 2005 and;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the City of Tontitown to repeal Ordinance No. 2005-3-204 and to enact an Ordinance, to regulate the meetings of the City Council and to make necessary technical corrections;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 2005-3-204 is hereby repealed;

Section 2: That the time for the regular meetings of the City Council shall be on the 1st Tuesday of every month, commencing at seven o'clock (7:00) p.m., beginning in April of 2005, or at any other times and dates as set by the City Council;

<u>Section 3</u>: That the City Council shall provide the times and places of holding its meeting, which shall at all times, be open to the public;

Section 4: That the Mayor or any three (3) Aldermen may call special meeting when it is necessary for the transaction of any special business before the next regular meeting, an it shall be the duty of the City Recorder / Treasurer of the City of Tontitown to cause written notice of all special meetings to be served on the Mayor and each member of the City Council, at least two (2) days before such special meeting(s), specifying therein in general terms the particular business to be brought before the City Council;

<u>Section 5</u>: That the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be separable, and if any provision shall for any reason be held illegal or invalid, it shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 6</u>: That all Ordinances and parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 7: That the City Council, of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, determines that an emergency exists in the administration of governmental operations in the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, and said governmental operations will be interrupted without regular City Council Meetings and this Ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall be in full force and be in effect from and after passage and approval.
