ORDINANCE NO. 2006-08-244

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2005-10-2318, ESTABLISHING A STREET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, (PASSED OCTOBER 4, 2005) DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas to Amend Ordinance No. 205-10-231 (passed October 4, 2005); and

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, has and maintains certain monies, financial accounts, liabilities and obligations; and

WHEREAS, the effective plan, operation, and administration of existing and future financial accounts, liabilities and obligations require administrative oversight in order to best maintain, develop and assure that the financial obligations of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, are maintained in a manner, which is in the best interest of the public and to address the development of the future of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, has and contains certain roadways and streets within its corporate boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the effective development, growth, operation and maintenance of those existing roadways and streets require administrative oversight in order to best maintain, develop and protect the roadways and streets, to create an atmosphere which is safe to the public, and to address the development of future roadways and streets; and WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, has expressed a desire to Amend Ordinance No. 2005-10-231 (passed October 4, 2005).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section one (1) of Ordinance No. 2005-10-231 (passed October 4, 2005) be amended to read as follows: That a Street and Finance Committee, for the City of Tontitown, is hereby established. The Committee shall consist of three (3) members with one (1) member from each ward and who shall be appointed by the Mayor and approved by the City Council for a term of one (1) year. At all times, the members of this Committee shall be Aldermen in the Tontitown City Council. Vacancies on the Committee shall be filled in the same manner as appointments.

Section 2: Emergency Clause: It is hereby declared that an emergency exists, in that, an effective plan, for the operation and administration of those existing, future and financial accounts, liabilities and obligation is needed, for the effective development and preservation of the financial records, liabilities and obligations of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, as well as a comprehensive plan for the construction, maintenance, development and preservation of the roadways and streets of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, and this Ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall be effective from and after its passage and approval.
