

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-02-281

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2005-10-231, ESTABLISHING A FINANCE COMMITTEE (PASSED OCTOBER 5, 2005) AND ORDINANCE NO. 2006-08-266, AMENDING ORDINANCE 2005-10-231 (PASSED AUGUST 1, 2006), IN ORDER TO ENACT AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AND CREATING A STREET COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas to repeal Ordinance No. 2005-10-231 (passed October 5, 2005) and Ordinance No. 2006-08-266 (passed August 1, 2006); and

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, has and contains certain roadways and streets within its corporate boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the effective development, growth, operation and maintenance of those existing roadways and streets require administrative oversight in order to best maintain, develop and protect the roadways and streets, to create an atmosphere which is safe to the public, and to address the development of future roadways and streets; and

WHEREAS, the needs as outlined above could be best accomplished by the creation of a committee dedicated to City Streets known as the Street Committee for the City of Tontitown;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a Street Committee for the City of Tontitown, is hereby established. The Committee shall consist of three (3) members with one (1) member from each ward and who shall be appointed by the Mayor and approved by the City Council for a term of one (1) year. At all times, the members of this Committee shall be Aldermen in the Tontitown City Council. Vacancies on the Committee shall be filled in the same manner as appointments.

Section 2: Members of the Committee shall not receive compensation for their services, except that members may recover costs and expenses in the event they are required to travel, pursuant to business related to the Committee.


Section 3 The Committee shall, if necessary, enact bylaws for its operation, and shall report, from time to time, to the City Council of Tontitown regarding the Committee's projects and overall operation.

Section 4: Emergency Clause: It is hereby declared that an emergency exists, in that, prior to the enactment of this Ordinance the duties of the Street Committee provided for herein were carried out by a Street and Finance Committee having responsibilities over both City streets and City finances;

that due to rapid growth and development within the City, the City Council has determined that it is necessary to immediately establish a Street Committee to focus on the construction, maintenance, development and preservation of the roadways and streets of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas; further, that the construction, maintenance, and development of the City streets are necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare; and, this Ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Tontitown, Arkansas, shall be effective from and after its passage and approval.
