AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2005-3-203 ESTABLISHING AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS

Whereas, the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, is currently and will continue to experience both economic and population growth; and

Whereas, the effective development, growth, operation and expansion of both the corporate boundaries and planning areas of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas would benefit from citizen input to best preserve, plan and protect the City of Tontitown and its citizens; to better promote communication between Government officials and citizens; to create an atmosphere which is inviting to the public-at-large for the present and future citizens of the City of Tontitown; and

Whereas, the needs as outlined above could be accomplished by the creation of an Advisory Committee for the City of Tontitown;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, THAT ORDINANCE 2005-3-203 SHALL BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That an Advisory Committee for the City of Tontitown is hereby established. The Committee shall serve in an advisory capacity only and shall consist of ten (10) citizens selected from the City's Wards who are qualified electors and who shall be appointed by the Mayor and approved by the Council for a term of (1) year. Two (2) additional members from within the City's Planning Area, who shall have no power to vote, may be appointed. Members from the Planning Area who are considered for appointment shall meet at least (1) criteria as set forth: Business and/or Property owner within the Corporate limits of the City residing in the City's Planning Area, current Utility Customer of the City in good standing, and/or Member of the Tontitown Area Fire Department. At all times, one (1) member of the Committee shall be a member of the Tontitown City Council, who shall serve in an ex-officio capacity and who shall serve as a liaison between the committee and the City Council and shall have no power to vote. Vacancies on the Committee shall be filled in the same manner as appointments.

<u>Section 2:</u> Members of the Committee shall not receive compensation for their services. Only with prior approval from the Mayor and/or City Council shall members be reimbursed for any expenses incurred when requested to travel and/or attend educational seminars relating to Committee projects.

<u>Section 3:</u> The Committee shall enact bylaws for its operation, and shall report monthly, on project assignments, to the City Council. The Committee's bylaws shall be reviewed

and approved annually by the Mayor and City Council. Projects may be assigned by the Mayor and/or Council. At no time shall the Committee be assigned projects or perform any function that will conflict with the decision-making authority or duties of the Mayor, Council, standing Committees, Commissions, or City Employees.
