WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown believes that it is in the best interests of the City to authorize its local government to enter into a cooperative purchasing agreement with the State of Arkansas.

WHEREAS, Arkansas' State Purchasing Law (A.C.A. 1987 §19-11-201) was signed into law by Governor Bill Clinton on March 21, 1979; and

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 1979, Arkansas' State Purchasing Law provides the opportunity for local public procurement units to participate in contracts of the State of Arkansas, Department of Finance and Administration, Office of State Procurement, for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain materials; now therefore,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the City of Tontitown Arkansas, that the City enter into a cooperative purchasing agreement with the State of Arkansas.

Section 1. The Mayor, upon approval by the City Council, hereby requests authority in the name of the City of Tontitown to participate in state contracts which the Department of Finance and Administration, Office of State Procurement, has entered into for the purchase of supplies, services equipment and certain materials pursuant to the State Purchasing Law and Amendment 54 to the Arkansas Constitution.

Section 2. That the Mayor, upon approval by the City Council, is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the City of Tontitown to be bound by all contract terms and conditions as the Department of Finance and Administration, Office of State Procurement, prescribes. Such terms and conditions may include a reasonable fee to cover the administrative costs which the Department of Finance and Administration incurs as a result of the City of Tontitown's participation in a contract. Further, that the Mayor, upon approval by the City Council, does hereby agree to be bound by all such terms and conditions.

Section 3. That the Mayor, upon approval by the City Council, is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the City of Tontitown to directly pay the vendor, under such state contract in which it participates, for items it receives pursuant to the contract, and that the Mayor, upon approval by the City Council, does hereby agree to directly pay
