ORDINANCE NO. 2009 - 09 -343

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NAME OF "FIRST" STREET TO "ROSO" STREET

WHEREAS, after a review of its maps and historical plots it was determined that a street ("First" Street) in Tontitown could have been named twice. The City of Tontitown believes it is in the best interests of its citizens to rename/restate the street historically known as "First" Street, but presently known as "Roso" Street.

WHEREAS, after thorough consideration the street that is due east and runs parallel to North Barrington Road and intersects with East Washington Avenue will be known as "Roso" Street from this date forward.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS.

SECTION 1. That the City of Tontitown has determined that a discrepancy exists regarding one of its streets. Tontitown's 1966 plot of city blocks illustrates a street known as "First Street" which runs parallel and east of North Barrington Road and intersects East Washington Avenue. This street will now be known as "Roso Street," and this revision was approved by the Tontitown Planning Commission, and recommended for City Council adoption, be and is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That any and all signs, notifications, and other documentation will henceforth reflect the name "Rosso" Street for the street formerly known as "First" Street.
