

ORDINANCE 2012-10-398

**AMENDING SECTION 30.01 (A) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES  
REGARDING REGULAR MEETING DATES FOR THE CITY COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, the City Council has the authority to establish the dates of its regular meetings; and

WHEREAS, the current Code calls for regular meetings to be held on the first Tuesday of each month; and

WHEREAS, holding Council meetings on the same day as general elections are held has the potential to unnecessarily delay, until the following month, City Council action on matters impacted by general election results; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considers such delays to be contrary to the efficient conduct of governmental affairs, and as such, wish to avoid such occurrences in the future by changing the regular meeting date in November of general election years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 30.01 (A) of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows: "The date for regular meetings of the City Council shall be on the first Tuesday of each month, except that during November of even numbered years, the regular meeting shall be held on the first Wednesday following the general election. All regular meetings of the City Council shall commence at 7:00 p.m."

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be, and are hereby repealed.
