

**ORDINANCE NO. 2015-\_\_ - \_\_**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2014-12-495; AMENDING THE TONTITOWN MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE III, BY THE REMOVAL OF SECTION 31.08 TITLED "BILL OF RIGHTS FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS"; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 31.08 was added to the Tontitown Municipal Code pursuant to the adoption of Ordinance No. 2014-12-495; and

**WHEREAS**, Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-52-301, *et al.*, grants to any municipality the authority to adopt all, part, or none of the provisions contained in Tontitown Municipal Code Section 31.08; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the city of Tontitown has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Tontitown to remove said provisions from the Municipal Code.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the city of Tontitown, Arkansas:

**Section 1:** That Ordinance No. 2014-31.08 is hereby repealed.

**Section 2:** That Title III, Section 31.08 of the Tontitown Municipal Code is amended by the removal of Section 31.08 titled "Bill of Rights for Law Enforcement Officers," in its entirety.

**Section 3.** **Emergency.** The City Council has determined that an emergency is hereby found to exist and this Ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication.
