**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO.
2014-11-552; AND THE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION
31.01, ESTABLISHING DUTIES AND DEFINING
POWERS OF THE PLANNING BOARD FOR THE CITY
OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS.**

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, has adopted an ordinance establishing a Planning Board by Ordinance No. 2014-11-552;

WHEREAS, the City Council has found the need to amend the duties and powers of the Planning Board; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas:

Section 1: That section 31.01 of the code of Ordinance for the City of Tontitown, Arkansas is hereby repealed and following Section 31.01 is substituted in its place.

31.01 PLANNING BOARD

- A. There is created a board of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, to be known as the Tontitown Planning Board which shall consist of seven (7) members, of whom at least two-thirds shall not hold any other municipal office or appointment except membership in the Board of Adjustments or a joint planning agency.
- B. The Planning Board shall have all the duties and functions authorized by Act 186 of the Acts of Arkansas 1957 or a joint planning agency.
- C. The members of the Planning Board shall be named, appointed and confirmed by the City Council. The appointment of the Planning Board members shall be made at the regular meeting of the City Council in February.
- D. The terms of the members of the Planning Board shall be two (2) years. However, the initial appointment to the Planning Board shall be; three (3) for one year, and four (4) for two years. Thereafter as vacancies occur in the Board, for whatever cause, the vacancies, shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointments, and the appointees shall hold office until expiration of the term which they were appointed to fill. All members of the Planning Board whose terms may expire shall serve until their successors in office have been appointed and confirmed by the City Council
- E. The time for the regular meetings of the Planning Board shall be on the fourth Tuesday of every month commencing at the time designated in the Planning

Board Bylaws. If for any reason the City Council believes that City business requires the Planning Board to meet twice a month, the City Council may, by motion approved by a majority of the Council members present, require the Planning Board to meet twice a month.

§ 31.01 PLANNING COMMISSION.

(A) There is created a commission of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, to be known as the Tontitown Planning Commission, which Commission shall consist of seven members, of whom at least two-thirds shall not hold any other municipal office or appointment except membership in the Board of Adjustment or a joint planning agency.

(B) The Planning Commission shall have all the duties and functions authorized by Act 186 of the Acts of Arkansas 1957, as amended.

(C) The members of the Planning Commission shall be named, appointed and confirmed by the City Council.

(D) The terms of the members of the Planning Commission shall be for three years. However, the initial appointment to the Commission shall be: three for one year, two for two years, and two for three years. The appointees shall draw for terms of office at the first meeting of the Commission. Thereafter as vacancies occur in the Commission, for whatever cause, the vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointments, and the appointees shall hold office until expiration of the term which they were appointed to fill. All members of the Planning Commission whose terms may expire shall serve until their successors in office have been appointed and confirmed by the City Council.

(E) The time for the regular meetings of the Planning Commission shall be on the fourth Tuesday of every month, beginning February 26, 2013, commencing at the time designated in the Planning Commissions Bylaws. If for any reason the City Council believes that city business requires the Planning Commission to meet twice a month, the City Council may, by motion approved by a majority of the Council members present, require the Planning Commission to meet twice a month. The Planning Commission Bylaws will be modified to reflect this requirement.
