## **BUILDING/PLANNING:**

The Planning Board will have a Public Hearing next THURSDAY, December 27<sup>th</sup>, regarding a re-zoning on Kissinger Road. The property owner is requesting a change from Agricultural to R-1. In addition to the rezoning, the board will also review a Large-Scale Development during their meeting following the hearing. Paramount Metals is requesting to add an 8000 s.f. storage building to their facility on W. Henri de Tonti.

## **STREETS/PARKS:**

The latest on the Klenc Road paving project? They are supposed to start tomorrow.

As I mentioned last month, we are going to try to get some grant money to re-hab the tennis courts in the park. I submitted applications this morning for both of them. I did have to get a cost estimate to put on the grant application, so I contacted Bryon Mick with Mick Construction. Bryon recently updated some courts in Fayetteville with a 5" post-tension concrete slab, which is what he recommends. The turn-key price is \$102,774. I know, I was surprised too.

Last month I reported that the water tank project was ready to begin. I am pleased to report that the foundation crew has already completed the footings. The steel crew is scheduled to be here this week to begin erecting the structure.
